Unlike many traders; Lachlan Lia regarded her as his mate & never
took another, altho he had a mistress in Pensacola when he met her.
The traditional Creek engagement involved the man placing a deer
at the lady's feet.

He was the youngest son of Chief of McG*'s of Dunmaglass,
who was a capt in Clan Chattan reg't in 1715. His older
bro Alex (son & heir) led the same reg't in '45 & was
killed at Well of Dead.

But Edward/J Cashin bk "Lachlan McG*, Indian Trader"
U of Georgia Press 1992; says he eldest SO Wm +
Janet McIntosh; & grd-SO Farq'r who built the mansion
house of Dunmaglass. Alex was his younger bro & Jean
was his sister. This maybe the Jean Roy of Don 87.
Alex wed **Eliz Patchabel** =Wm 1753

Farq'r had been rewarded for his loyalty to the Stuarts, in 1685,
with the pos'n of comm'r of supply. He d.1714. His eldest son
Farq'r (7th chief) was capt in '15 & Wm (2nd son)
was a lieut. The surrender at Preston saw 16 McG*'s
taken prisoner; 13 were transported to SC; including
Arch, John & an older Lachlan. Farq'r & Wm were
allowed to go home. Wm was called Capt Ban because
of his white hair. Wm lived at Dunmaglass & wed Janet McIntosh
9 Feb 1714. (maybe b.1684) Farq'r lived at Gask. It
appears they had another bro Don, of Dalcrombie.

This version denies Lachlan 'ran away' & that he
was recruited with 146 others; including his cousin
Farq'r (age 30) & Arch 67 (age 15). There were already
clansmen in Georgia. The "Prince of Wales" sailed
20 Oct 1735 & arr Jan 1736 at Savannah.

The older Lachlan had pioneered in the trade but had d.1735.

One of the 1st settlers in Augusta was John McG*. He was a charter member of local St Andrew's Soc. which was formed 1729.

The 42nd reg't was in Georgia in 1739. (but would Scots have been in it prior to the '45?)

A Dan'l McDonald seems to have changed his name to McG*.

He was a messenger for Lachlan who has him in his Will, made 1767.

His son was "Bit Nose Billy McG*".

The new chief (Capt) Wm (+ Johanna McKenzie of Fairburn whose son =John/Lachlan) was talked into coming to Georgia where he became a planter. He returned to Scot at the start of the Rev'n & planned to raise troops in Strathnairn. He wed late & fathered an heir.

Lachlan also encouraged Wm's younger bro John to emigrate & became a successful trader (with L's help).

Farq'r of Dalcrombie had managed the estate in his absence & after he d. in Portugal.

John raised 100 men to defend the Mississippi; he was "the fittest person" to manage the Indians around Mobile. Sailing to Savannah he was captured & imprisoned in Havana for 10 mo's.

Lachlan's bro Alex seems to have come directly to Charlestown & was a successful sea capt.

Farq'r, Lachlan's cousin was a carpenter & a Presby min.

Lachlan was soon fluent in Creek & was taken on trading missions. He had his own post in 1743.

Sehoy b.1740 (but she'd only be 10 when Alex b. - altho another source says he b.1759), DO Geo, a French trapper; or the Fr commander of Ft Toulouse who was killed there 1722 by his own soldiers (records don't confirm this); or the Capt Louis Marchand de Courtel, commander of the Alabama district in the 1720's. Said to be a Fr officer of Spanish descent who wed Sehoy Hatali, of the powerful Wind Clan of Creek Indian Confederacy. (or dau b.c1720; Tuskegee, Alabama & wed c1745; or said to be 16 when wed) Sehoy 2 said to have been 1st marr to Toakabatch; & that marr =Sehoy 3 (below) who wed Tate & then Weatherford.

He ran away from home (Dunmaglass) 10 Jan 1735, to SC at age 16. Joined with some traders & got experience.

Settled in Augusta, Georgia <1751. Indian trader in Georgia & Carolina's for 37 yrs prior to the Rev'n.

On 26 July 1775 Savannah's leading citizens met to discuss the war; electing Lachlan to chair the meeting & it was his name ascribing the resolutions in the Georgia Gazette. He was elected to the prov'l congress. But, the newcomers had no tolerance for Indian rights & took up the Baptist religion & maintained their petty hatreds & feuds from Ireland & Scot. The Scots remained loyal & later Georgia would ban further immigration from Scot.

Dan'l Clark; Will, of Augusta, GA, now of Charlestown, Indian trader, bro is Alex Clark of Petty par near Castle Steuarth near Inv; mentions Lachlan McGullvray, exec to above will; Alex McGullvray & wife; John McG & Wm McG.

Supposed to have been 15,000 HL'rs in N Carolina <1773.
Lachlan Lea in 1781 was old & infirm, & gave 24 estates in
Georgia to nephew & heir John (in Florida) in exchange for a life annuity.
John employed Lachlan yr (SO Arch 67) to manage the Vale Royal one
until it was confiscated in May 1782. (BUT mix up there)
Lachlan Lea's cousin Wm was in Georgia. Both Lachlans & Wm
were in Ldn 1784.

Lachlan (& other loyalists were given 6mo's to settle
their affairs after the war; he sailed May 1782 & his
estates were confiscated. His name was 4th (after the
gov, his son & the Lt gov) on the proscribed list.
Wm's was 73rd on the Chatham co list; & John 96th.
John sailed for Jamaica Apr 1783, established a plantation at
Bath there in 1786, which Lachlan yr managed. Lachlan was
also said to be at Black R. in 1788.

John d.Feb 1788 in Jamaica (or while returning to Eng).
Left fortune to John Lachlan & nothing
to Lachlan yr who had helped him for 10 yrs & to whom
he owed £3,200 back pay. The elder Lachlan Lia (Gray
Lachlan) acknowledged this debt & pd him £500/yr from
John's estate. Lachlan Lia moved to Inv & lived with
Anne, sister to John & Wm. He became trustee for 7 yr
old John Lachlan's estates (whose mother seems also to
have d.); Dunmaglass, Easter Aberchalder, Inverairnie,
Wester Gask, Easter Gask, Faillie & Lairgs. His
American plantation skills made him a much better mgr
than Farq'r had been; he reforested the area, intro'd
improvements & poured in his own funds.

Lachlan Lia was "fat & healthy" at age 64 in Eng.
Lachlan stated he lost over £23,000 & John £27,000; but
their claims for recompense were accepted.

He d.16 Nov 1799; Inv (Georgia M's & D's)

John, nephew & heir to above; was also a trader in Georgia
& W Fla with Indians. Loyalist & Lt Col W Fla Volunteers.
1778 to Natchez, 1779 to Savannah & Pensacola, Spanish
prisoner, later to Jamaica. 1784/5 of St Martin's in the
Fields, London; claim re Georgia lands he bought 1762/6
& lost; claimed £27,000, got £9,000. 1773 gave some lands
to Capt Wm McG (see below).

John Lachlan SO dec'd Capt Wm McG* of Dunmaglass by John
McG* of Jamaica; Adjudications WRH DI 14

He d.'52; 10th chief of Dunmaglass. He had succeeded his father as a young boy (as had his father, on the d. of his bro at Culloden. Together they held sway for >100 yrs. John Lachlan was very wealthy & owned 7 estates in Strathnairn & Stratherrick. He rarely visited them, preferring to live at Drummond in Inv & to travel extensively on the Continent. An Inv law agent managed them. In his Will he gave each tenant a yrs rent; & much to charity. (Jane has Will)

Another nephew was Ward Coachman

A list of Georgia Loyalists who settled in Jamaica has John Esq, Lachlan & Lachlan jr.

Lachlan Jr, managing John's estates in Georgia (Christ Church par); lived in Sabine Georgia, to Eng 1781, 1782 to Jamaica, 1784 living in London (Westminster).

Capt Wm was 1 of only 3 Clan Chattan officers to survive Cullodan (Farq'r 9 of Dalcrombie was another; according to a clan hist). Wm was ½ pay Br Officer, Capt in 89th Ft in 1759, discharged 1762; came to Georgia 1773 at wish of cousin (worth >£30,000) who promised to make him heir.

Went to Georgia & bought estates "to the ruin of his property in Br, where he is head of a clan". His bro John went to US 1755. Loyalist, imprisoned 1776, banished.

[Woodie Wallace Sr in Mobile, Al (Sylvia's cousin; now d.) was very knowledgable re Lachlan, Col John & Alex; & had picture of Alex & Sehoj. His papers went to his 2nd son.

He says that after the French vacated the S. in 1763,

John (or Chas) Stuart was appointed superintendent of Indian Affairs; & that he designated Lachlan (Savannah)

to supervise trade with the Cherokees & Creeks; & Lachlan's cousin Lt Col John McG* to deal with the Chickasaws & Choctaws (from Mobile). He says their cousin Wm was Chief of the clan then.

He says his ancestor (Alex's sister Sophia's dau, Rachel Durant) talked with Alex & that he described himself as "in some sort a lone man (who) had nobody about him to do things for him.")

He says Geo McG* found Lachlan's Will & that it's now with a prof at U. of Florida in Pensacola (& that Cashin knows of it). Will dated 12 June 1767 at Vale Royal, Georgia; it gives Alex's b.date.

He was Indian chieftain in 1776. He had great status & could field 10,000 warriors. Called "Hoboi-Hilr-Miko" in Creek, meaning "Big Mac".

Sent to Charleston, S.C., for a classical education, by Lachlan's bro (or cousin) Farquhar McG* (a Scot Presby Min; but not in Ch records) & his wife Amy. Farq'r was said to be a cabinet-mkr in Charlestown 1753, & so Alex likely also apprentised as a mercht.

Farq'r McG* of Dalcrombie vs Lachlan McG*, mercht in Charleston, SC, eldest SO Wm, bro of Farq'r of Drumnaglash; 8 Mar 1755 for £100 he had loaned him before he left. WRH Also, Alex McG*, Carolina mercht vs heirs of Hugh Fraser of Kinainids, 9 Feb 1742

Young Alex had

killed an Indian boy in a fight & it was thought best he leave for awhile. Apprenticed to a counting-house.

(An Arch immig to Charleston, 1770.) He had many fine

qualities but not everyone appreciated them. "The Spanish are devils, but the biggest devil among them is the ½ Spanish, ½ Frenchman, ½ Scotsman & altogether Creek scoundrel McG*" (Scottish Notes & Queries v6, 2nd series p.148).

When his father returned to Scot, Alex returned to Alabama & became chief of the Upper Creeks. Their lands were coveted by the Fr, Spanish, Americans & Br. so Alex had to use all his political skills & intrigue to keep the lands intact.

In 1778, while the course of the War was yet undetermined the Br made him a colonel to keep him on their side. But, this resulted in the victorious Americans confiscating some territory.

As emperor of the Creeks & Seminoles, negotiated a treaty with Spain in Pensacola in 1784 & became the Spanish representative to Creek Indians in Florida 1784, fought against American settlers treaty of New York 1790.

Links to Panton, Leslie & Co, John Forbes & Co. Indian traders.

His hope was to secure a type of United States of Indian tribes.

He was forced to negotiate with the the US & was regarded as one of the shrewdest Indians in treaty negotiations. He was called the Tallyrand of Alabama. In 1790, he visited Gen Washington & the congress in NY city; where he & 30 other chiefs concluded a treaty. He was made a brigadier gen'l with an annual salary of \$1200. The Spanish king also made him superintendant-gen'l for the Creeks with an annual salary of \$3500. Despite all this he seemed to have kept his tribe's interests foremost. After the Rev'n he kept the land greedy Georgian's at bay & refused to be coaxed, cajoled or threatened. He was an astute negotiator with all sides.

Seems to have disliked fighting & have been very smart.

His actions brought his tribe another generation of freedom which they finally lost under lesser leaders.

"He had the polished urbanity of the Frenchman, the duplicity of the Spaniard, the cool sagacity of the Scot & the silent subtlety & inveterate hate of the NA Indian". He was "the very soul of the Creek Nation"

During his later yrs he wrote a history of the Creeks & sent it to an Edinburgh Prof, who d. & the mss was lost (likely stolen).
 The insatiable appetite of the frontier people for land & the greed of powerful speculators would nullify the ½ hearted gov't efforts to transform hunters into sedentary farmers; & they were dispossessed.

I drop these lines to inform you that we sailed on the 14th of July & arrived here
on the 12th of Aug--being at Quebec--we had no mishaps among us on board
except the death of Alex MacKellar from Lochgilphead whose corpse was cast
overboard on the 4th day of us setting sail. When we arrived at Quarantine Island
there were 21 vessels at anchor before us, all full of passengers. We arrived one
day previous to them that sailed before us. I have to inform you that all the
emigrants got a very favourable passage at sea, but I am sorry to say that great
numbers of them suffered on their arrival at Toronto.

John Campbell and his wife (see Alex 34) died and their children are with Neil
McGilvray. And Neil McGilvray (11) who left Shiaba and his wife and daughter
and the youngest bairn and Malcolm Campbell and his wife died also and a
daughter of Alexander MacDonald of Suie who left Iona. Robert Campbell who
left Shiaba died after taking cold water (being too hot)--We left Quebec on
Tuesday and arrived at Toronto on Sunday. The expenses between Quebec and
Toronto were 8/- a head and luggage free and I was on Tuesday next at eleven
o'clock at John, my uncle's house where I stayed more than 3 months. The country
is very plenteous and we have a very fresh crop of potatoes. Provisions are too
cheap. Wheat sells at about 3/8 per 60 lb bag, which is called a bushel. People are
very well off as far as I have seen as yet and have their living in earnest. My uncle
killed 7 pigs and a cow for his table. Land is very scarce about here and they have
a ready market for everything they can part with and as convenient as though they
were near Glasgow. A man with money might do well in Canada and might
double his capital in a few years. There is many a man buys land here and then
sells doubling his money. A man with a strong family willing to labour will soon
become independent and a man with a helpless family need not look to think he
will be better off here than at home. There are carding mills and Fouling mills and
grist mills within 2 miles on every hand you will turn here.

Tell Lachlan that his father is anxious to see him and if he can see an opportunity
to come next year or his son at any rate. (sounds like Arch has a son Lachlan &
that he also has a grd-son old enuf to emigrate on own) I was not up yet at the
new country which they call at home Owen Sound. It is so divided into districts

by which the old names will soon be extinct, but there is no grants given just now. What was granted is all taken up by the settlers as fast as they could survey it.

Tell Donald MacLean (Mary Hoff's 3x grd-dad; bro of Ida's Ann McLean) that I have not seen Hugh MacLean, his brother as yet, but I have seen some of the family: Big Malcolm, John and Margaret. (Two of Hugh McLean's kids in Vaughan. Malc was there till 1851; Margt all her life) I mind very well that I was talking to him coming to Portilm & that I said I would not advise him to come, but I now say he should rue that he did not come sooner. Tell him from me to come & I hope he will have a favourable passage.

I am not fit to give you any account about the winters in Canada but as much as I have seen of it I have never seen so favourable. They fodder all their cattle & sheep outbye, except horses & calves which are wintered in houses fitted for their reception. I have seen John McGilvray (58) who left Shiaba going to Owen Sound where he bought 200 acres of land (all paid for with cash) & 2 cows and sheep and a yoke of oxen and wagons. The wagons would have cost about £20, and has bought since another 100 acres of land. Archie his son told me he had saved about £100 besides clothes and other expenses since he came to this country. Tell Archie MacKinnon that his brothers are well. Donald built a fine dwelling house of a frame, prettier than any bungalow. Tell Rachel that I have seen her brothers and sisters and are all well. I was there three days threshing to Malcolm and he has as much wheat as would feed all the inhabitants of Scoor and Kilviceon. Tell Catherine McGilvray that her sisters are all well and her brother Neil, and as good a farmer as left the Boss. Tell the soldier that I have seen his brother's son John at Montreal and are all well. I do not rue anything but the scarcity of Gaelic preachers. There is none in the township but one Baptist school is very convenient and Malcolm is going to school daily.

My Compliments to all my old neighbors and I hope I shall see a goodly number of them inhabiting Canada yet for there is no Factor, Ground Officer nor Donald Drover here to meddle with you. The wife sends her compliments to all her friends and expects to send a letter herself by which she will name you separately.

I must conclude as my space is getting short and more news rushing to my mind. Archibald MacGillvray December 28th 1849.

P.S. I have given you an account of every one to my recollection except myself. I have built a new house and I have plenty of potatoes and pork and flour to my satisfaction. Finlay MacNeil and his sons hauled to my door with his oxen my winter firewood. Finlay has as much wheat this winter as would feed the half of Uisken.

I would like to inform you about the clothes that are answerable in Canada which is shirtings and trowsers as much as you can for any that will come. Moleskin is a very good article for the fields of Canada but prints are dearer here. Books are very dear, Gaelic especially and Testaments and Bibles.

John's son Arch (1896-1967) states "In the early days my father told me that they had to make everything by hand; cloth, shoes & blacksmith's charcoal. Axes & scythes were treasures. There was quite a settlement of Glengarry people around us & a little Presb church in the woods, in which my grd-dad (John Sr. 1821-1894; wed to Mary McGillivray) was a leading light. The families gathered at our place on Sunday so they could all speak Gaelic. My father & his bro's removed to the USA. in 1880; worked in the woods in winter, drove logs on the Mississippi in the spring and homesteaded in Dakota. In Oct 1901 my father & his family moved to Alta. He prospered and was twice floored but kept on fighting and came up on top again."

John was a remarkable personality with a rugged constitution. At the age of 100 he underwent surgery and wanted to get out of bed the next day.

Son Arch led an eventful life travelling extensively in Cda and throughout the Yukon.

When Joyce Thomson, a desc - tried to get info she found many of the desc's tight-lipped - it appears that something dire happened in Ont <1880 when John Darroch and his bro's moved to the USA, and nobody was willing to talk about it.

John Darroch is from a different branch of the McGillivray's. In 1879 he moved with his parents and siblings to Lake County, SD. He was named after Rev John Darroch of Lochiel. To Ponoka, Alta 1901

Her parents wed "according to the custom of the country" (i.e. a First Nations "marriage", not legal, as he left his 3 'illegitimate' children provided for in his will). Mary was the 3rd of 4 kids. At the time of this 'marriage', Wm was with HBC at York Factory & all 4 kids were born there. When Wm was promoted & sent to R.R, he remarried legally (& had 4 more children). However, prior to marriage #2, he sent all 4 of his (very young original kids back to Stromness - to have them properly educated & brought up. They are called 'lodgers' which was the term used when youngsters were fostered with relatives or good friends.
It's unknown what happened to Margt. Three of the kids d. fairly young - the boy (eldest) at 20, Mary at 35 & Harriet at 23, presumably they were not too healthy (the boy & Harriet died of epilepsy). Mary died 8 mo's after the birth of her 2nd child, who himself died at birth.
The Dunardry family had a Simon McTavish (who brought Wm & his bro Geo over to 'Canada' in 1833 to work with him. Simon is said to have married (in 'Canada') into the McG* of Dunmaglas family. Maybe related to the elder Simon of the NWCo fame; see Don 89.

Campbell McIntosh, Inv Town Clk, was agent for his creditors; John MacG at Keppoch, (see Ron 1) Wm MacG at Balnacarnish, Farq'r MacG at Dalreach, Dunc & Mary McPherson at Keppoch & John Thomson, writer in Inv.. (Inv Crt of Session)
