(She lived in Saugeen with son Peter for some years but

lot into a church glebe; Parl pet'n; says McG came  
here 1830.

On 25 Mar'37 he petitions for 18-9c V. a CR; he has  
140 acres & bro-in-law Rod McKechnie (not on OPR & not

60 acres; have been here for 7 yrs; ½ of farm is rough
