MCGILVRAY MULL REBELS

Highland Papers v1 pp.296/303
in Publications of the Scottish Record Society
2nd series vol 5; May 1914. EPL

At this time the Campbells were using the courts to complete the takeover of Duart's lands in Mull. The McLeans, & their followers, were issued Letters of Caption & Ejection. This list of 455 men may include all those who had fought for the McLeans & thus should be a fairly accurate census of all males, including cottars & crofters as well as the tenants. However, the relatively few men from the same location indicates only heads of households, & maybe only tenants, were listed. And, those McGilvrays residing on non-Duart lands, such as Lochbuie & Iona would be excluded. The location of many place names is unknown but some are off Mull; eg. Kinlochaline, Morvern. (Vic basically means grand-son of.)

AN ANALYSIS OF THE MCGILVRAY POPULATION

In order to estimate the total McGilvray population, in 1675, the following assumptions have been made;

- that the 34 men listed above are McGilvrays (i.e. M'Ilvorish, M'Ulvoyll & McDonald vic Ilvray) & were separate household heads
- that they were half the McGilvrays on Duart lands (to include crofters, cottars, etc)
- that a further 12 families lived in other areas of Mull
- that another 40 families lived in the other isles (Islay, Jura Tyree & Colonsay) & in Ardnamurchan & Morvern
- that a further 30 families lived in Lorne (see Appendix 2)
- that the average family size was $5\frac{1}{2}$ (as per 1779 census)
- that Skye has been ignored due to a lack of early records & because no one can figure out if they should be considered with the McGillivrays of Inverness or with the McGilvrays of Mull; or, are completely separate.

For what it is worth, this equals 80 families & 440 McGilvrays on Mull & a total of 150 families & 825 McGilvrays. Of course, all of these many assumptions are open to argument & anyone else is welcome to make their own.

And, calculated from another point of view, the whole McLean clan fielded 400 fighters in 1689. (see p.154) Assuming they left another 400 for home protection then these 800 men would be their total male population between 16 & 60. Thus, the 99 Mull McGilvray fencibles would represent 12% of this force. Although this seems high, the McGilvrays did represent $6\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the total Ross & Brolass population in 1779, excluding Pennyghael, Glenliddle & Carsaig. And, by that time, there had been a definite influx of 'foreign' names into the area, & some McGilvray departures.

List was done at Inveraray Court House.

A list of 28 McGilvray rebels (R), in mainland Argyll, was done by parish in the fall of 1685. The three most serious McGilvray offenders forfeited their stock on 12 Oct 1685. Although these three should be on the initial list it was not possible to identify each one. Some spellings may have been missed & some were not included such as, McIlleriavich, McIlrivich, McIlrash, McIlvrion, McGillvib, McGilborid, McOlvid, McIlbryd, McIlbreid, McIlborid, McIlerane, McIllevin, McIllevoyll, McIclerich, McIenvoell, McIlshynie, McIlverchar, McIlguirme, McIlluy, McOlvei, McOlvea, McIlvuy, McOlva, McIlvey & McVorish.

A list of 13 fencible McGilvray men (F) (i.e. ages 16 - 60) in mainland Argyll was drawn up 26 May 1692. This will often include more than one man per household & sometimes overlapped with the above list. However, it is unlikely that the known rebels, of only 7 years before, would be desired or so listed. Spellings are once again very problematic; such as McIlvernock, who were very common.

It is debatable if these totals can be combined but it appears there were 39 separate men or about 30 households.

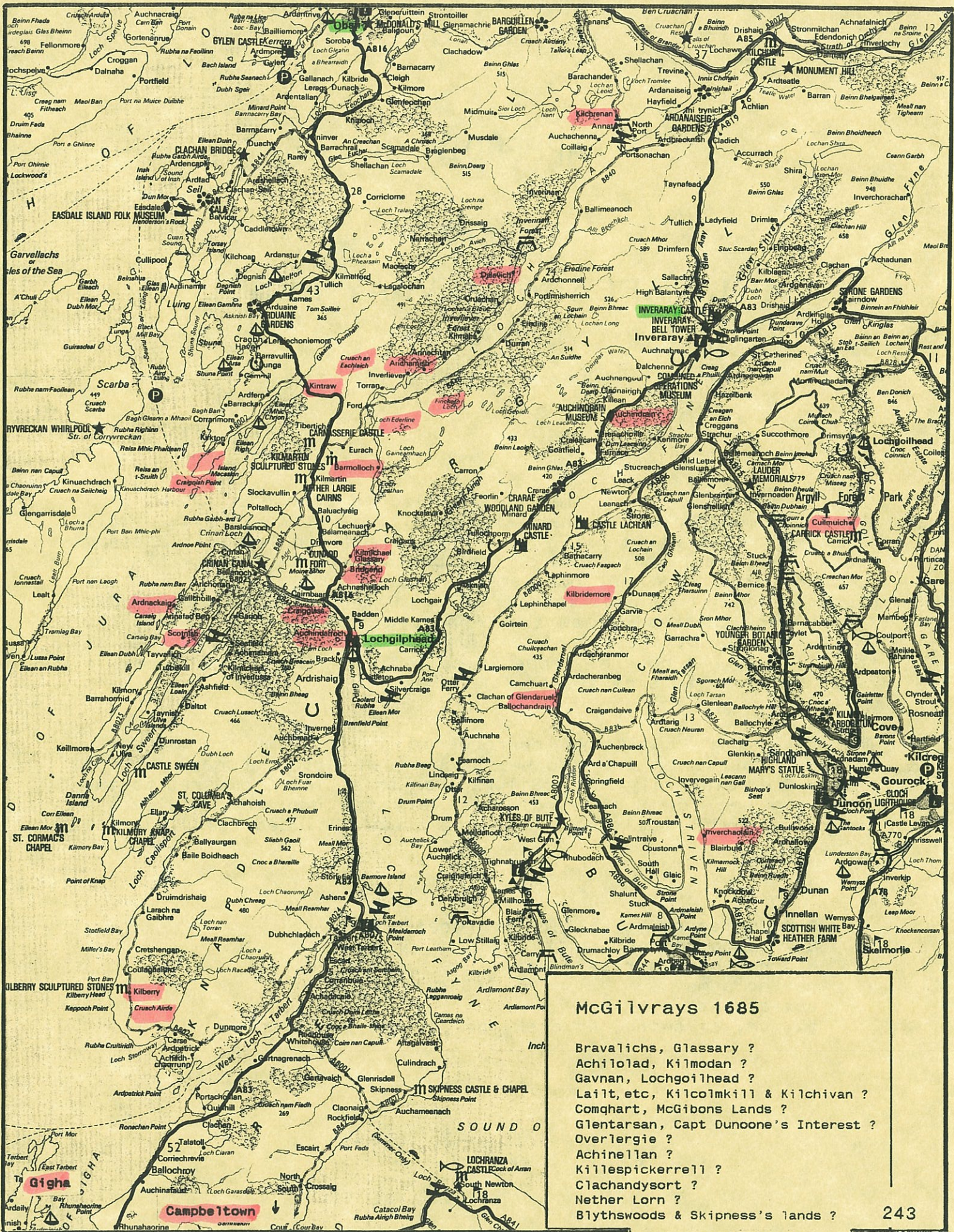

APPENDIX 3

MULL AREA MCGILVRAY REBELS

(SRO CS54/22/51 & 52)

A total of 44 McGilvray men were called to surrender their arms after the collapse of the 1715 Rebellion. The 31 from Mull compares to the 34 in 1675. As with the earlier list, it appears these names are likely those of rent paying tenants rather than the complete area fencible population (ages 16-60). The list was predetermined (from rent lists?), along with their place of abode, & they were checked off as they appeared. It is also considered unlikely that cottars & crofters would own guns. However, some of those listed had no arms & one is called old & poor; so it may in fact, be close to a census of fencibles.

The following McGilvrays surrendered their arms at Mangarie (Mingary Castle on the southwest coast of Ardnamurchan) 16 Apr 1716. The relatively few McGilvrays on this list, compared to the following one for Mull, indicates very few non-Mull McGilvrays lived in Argyll rebel areas. Secure areas included Islay, Jura & Lorne.
